Men's Shelter of Charlotte is proud to release this inaugural quarterly community *Impact Report*. MSC's *Impact Report* illustrates progress towards targets, comparing this year to last. We're demonstrating how MSC is ending homelessness for each man we serve. We're also showing that our scattered sites approach to rapid rehousing is succeeding by mapping where we have moved men into rental housing *throughout* our community.

MSC is proud to be on track to move 500 men into more appropriate housing this year! Most men moving into more appropriate housing are renting apartments or reuniting with family – in *permanent housing*! Others moving from our shelters are continuing their journey to recovery by accessing supportive housing programs. Some men are moving into assisted living facilities, group homes, and even hospice – all more appropriate housing situations than remaining in emergency shelter.

MSC's *Impact Report* clearly demonstrates our commitment to ending homelessness. We're very thankful for our community stakeholders. MSC doesn't work alone. We rely on you – our partner agencies, volunteers, donors, and community champions. The successes illustrated in this report are realized through the hard work of the men we serve, through our dedicated staff, and through *you*. Thank you for being part of MSC's community impact!

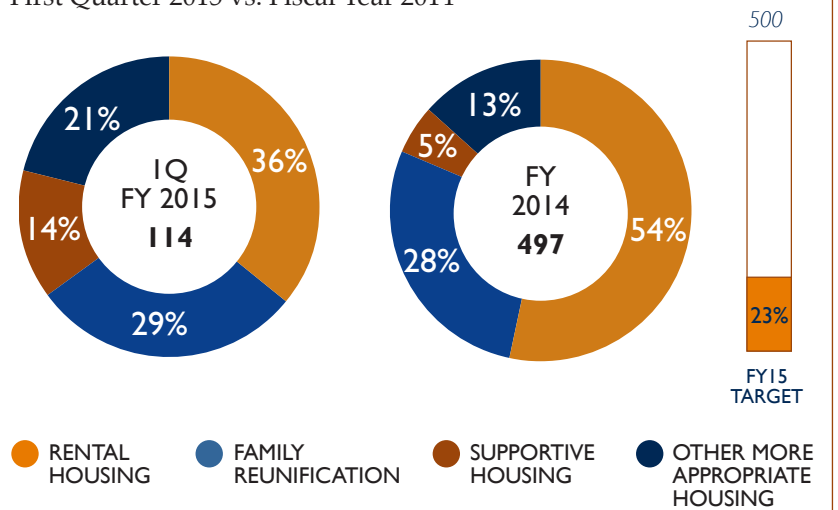


HOUSING LOCATION MAP

Scattered Sites Rental Units

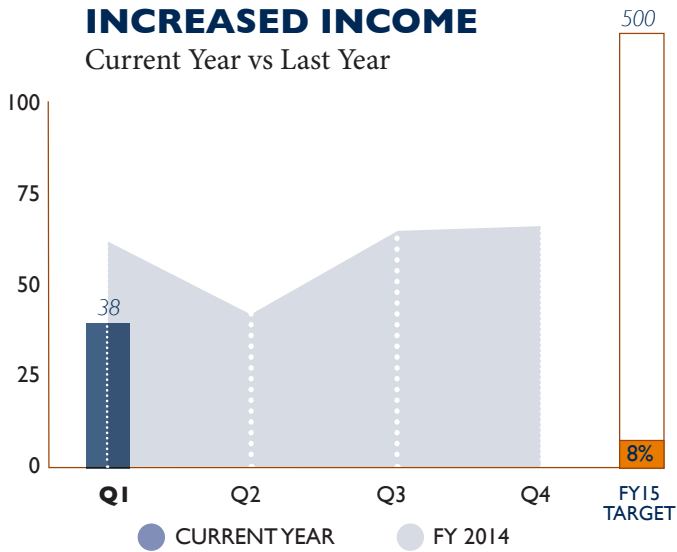
NUMBER OF MEN SERVED AND WHERE THEY ARE MOVING

First Quarter 2015 vs. Fiscal Year 2014



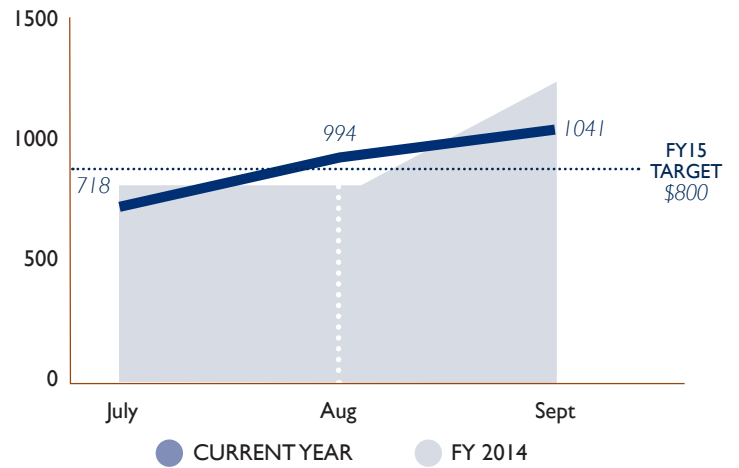
INCREASED INCOME

AVERAGE INCOME (in dollars)

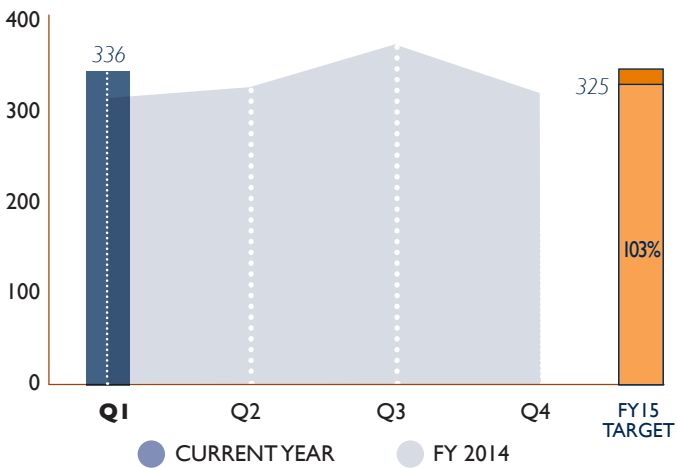
Current Quarter vs FY2014 Same Quarter

(Avg. Nightly Census)

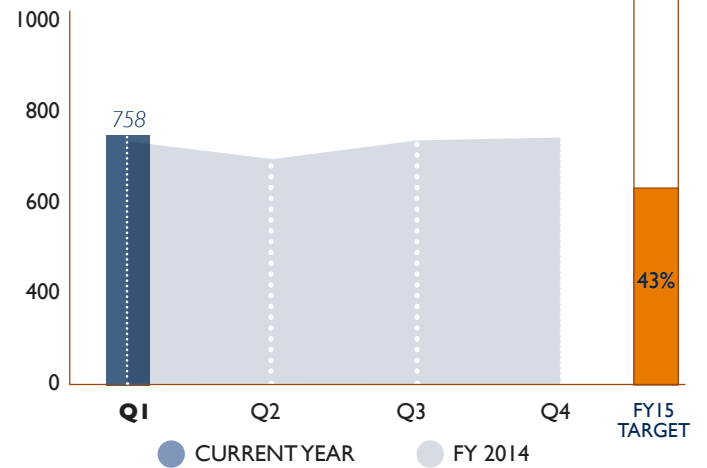
Current Year vs Last Year



CLIENTS SERVED

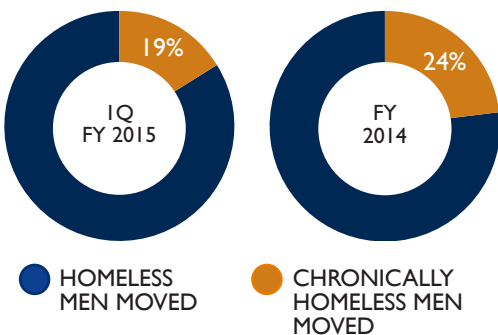
(Unduplicated Count)

Current Year vs Last Year



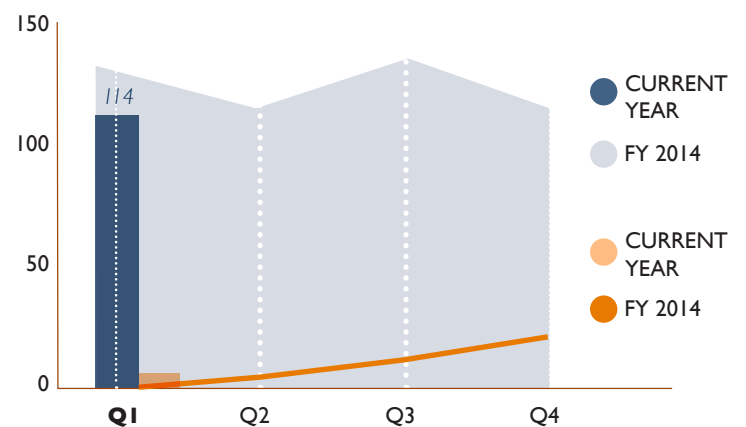
HOUSING CHRONICALLY HOMELESS MEN
