What is Diversion?

Diversion is an opportunity for assessment to determine if the individual has other resources or housing options other than shelter. Diversion is NOT a homeless prevention program nor is it a housing program.

Who is eligible for the diversion program at MSC?

Men currently experiencing homelessness in Mecklenburg County.

How do I refer someone for diversion?

Referrals will not be accepted for diversion. The man experiencing homelessness must present at MSC Tryon Campus.

What If it is determined I'm not eligible for diversion?

The man experiencing homelessness will continue through our intake process to determine if he meets the eligibility requirements for shelter.

How are the diversion services of MSC funded?

If financial assistance is needed for the diversion plan, the majority of these funds come directly from MSC programming funds. Recently MSC received a small grant from the Charlotte Housing Investment Partnership that will provide financial assistance for diversion activities.
